Case Study Pharmacist



The Case

Pharmacist working for a private pharmacy and health clinic in Knightsbridge (London) was accused of dishonesty in dispensing prescriptions whilst he had a lapsed premises licence and also accused of falsifying records to cover it up before allegedly lying to a General Pharmaceutical Council (GPhC) inspector. Without doubt the pharmacist risked being struck off the register.

After a thorough investigation by Stephen that included checking of email accounts and phone records, Stephen successfully cross-examined the GPhC inspector and was able to raise doubts about the merits of the case and allegations.

Outcome

All allegations found not proved by GPhC. Pharmacist issued warning for a single paperwork mistake and lapsed registration.
